Content

The goal is to expand students' knowledge of the interpersonal communication process, types of communication, and communication barriers. Students will be introduced to the nature of interpersonal communication with individuals with different types of disabilities in everyday situations. The aim is for students to understand the importance of effective interpersonal communication with disabilities. Additionally, students will be trained to develop skills in interpersonal communication with individuals with disabilities and to engage in effective communication with their families, ensuring meaningful and inclusive interactions.
