COURSE DESCRIPTION (EN/L1 [if taught in L1])

Content

The aim of the course is to enable students to differentiate between the concepts of cultural difference, cultural pluralism, multiculturalism and interculturalism, and multicultural and intercultural education and to achieve a positive attitude towards cultural differences in students so that they become interculturally sensitive and competent. The students will be capable of critically evaluating different programs and approaches to multicultural/intercultural education and accepting the principles of cultural pluralism and a critical dialogic perspective in improving schools, curricula and teachers

Competences & Learning Objectives

The students will be able to do the following:

Explain the difference between the concepts of cultural difference, cultural pluralism, multiculturalism, interculturalism, multicultural education and intercultural education and the relationships between these concepts.

Critically analyze how the attitude towards others as culturally different has changed through 4 periods (the golden age of ignorance, the disturbing age of political rhetoric, the promising age of adaptation, the challenging age of dialogue)

Recognize international and domestic formal-legal documents, standards and mechanisms that promote the idea of cultural pluralism

Critically evaluate various programs of multicultural/intercultural education

Demonstrate intercultural sensitivity, multiperspectivity and skills of intercultural dialogue

Advocate the principle of cultural pluralism as a social and professional value and a critical and dialogical perspective in improving schools, curricula and teachers
