COURSE DESCRIPTION (EN/L1 [if taught in L1])
<p>Content</p> <p>The aim is to expand the student's knowledge of fundamental communication postulates and theories that explain how people establish and develop mutual communication. The student will be trained to understand the stages of the communication process, as well as to analyze the dynamics of communication competence and interaction between participants. Additionally, the student will acquire skills to recognize and classify different relational contexts in which communication takes place, which is essential for successful professional and personal communication.</p>

Competences & Learning Objectives

The student recognizes the role of communication in interpersonal relationships, classifies acquired terminology, and interprets relevant theories. They compare and analyze communication skills, identifying their own communication patterns. Furthermore, the student is able to evaluate communication behavior across different contexts, demonstrating an understanding of how communication adapts to various relational and situational dynamics.

Terminology and Theories – Get to know the key terms and theories that explain the communication process.
