Content

This seminar draws on several theoretical areas from linguistics, sociology, and anthropology that deal with the rules and tendencies of human behavior.

Examples of theoretical texts that students will work with:

- Brown and Levinson **Politeness Theory**
- Steven Pinker Language as a Window to Human Thought
- Ang Soon and Linn Van Dyne Cultural Intelligence

Students will attempt to apply these concepts to various case studies contained in David Livermore's texts.

They will further examine the effectiveness of specific concepts presented in his book.

Key concepts:

- Motivation
- Knowledge
- Strategy
- Performance

These principles will provide students with an environment where they can analyze themselves and gradually improve their abilities within the framework of **intercultural communication competence**. Each week, students will analyze one case of intercultural communication:

- Initially between English and Czech
- Gradually between other cultures that come into contact with an Anglophone context.

Competences & Learning Objectives

Students analyze texts of intercultural communication based on concepts such as Motivation, Knowledge, Strategy, and Performance and expand their understanding of the signs and codes of English as a global language.
