Content 1. Seminar program, requirements for the student, method of concluding the seminar, literature. Cultivated spoken speech. 2. Introductory speeches on a given topic - analysis of the most common shortcomings. 3. Breathing as a basic condition for speaking. Breathing exercises. 4. Voice exercises, sound means of coherent speech. 5. Principles of articulation, exercises. 6. Prepared public speech on a given topic, verbal contact means. 7. Non-verbal means of communication - body language. 8. Expressive readiness - unprepared spoken speech. 9. Prepared public speech. 10. Expressive reading - analysis of a sample text, subsequent joint reading. 11. Individual expressive reading (texts of one's own choice). 12. Final prepared speeches - on a free topic.	
Competences & Learning Objectives To introduce students to verbal and non-verbal means of spoken communication and their function, to introduce types and forms of public communication, to consolidate the skill of publicly presenting a given topic (from the field of Czech realities - history, geography, culture, etc.)
