FRAMEWORK CONDITIONS -Formalities

- Submission Deadline: 15 April 2024 (23:59 CET)
- Eligibility: Collaborative proposals by staff of at least <u>three</u> consortium members
- Content Requirements: Project has to display clear reference to Work Package activities and/or Flagship Actions
- Announcement of Selection Results: June 2024
- Project Start:
 1 September 2024 or later
- Project Duration: max. 1 year



FRAMEWORK CONDITIONS -Formalities

- Financial restrictions:
 - Each institution funds their own contribution
 - local regulations of the respective home institution apply to all expenditures
 - Each institution sets their own maximum sum per project
 - Institution with no cost commitment:
 - A partner can participate in applications, but can not claim cost within the application
 - If a contributing partner wants to cover cost for a no-cost partner, it has to be approved by your home institution prior to submitting the application
 - Sums per project committed for the second EUPeace Fund Call:

COMILLAS: 5.000 € CU: -JLU: 5.000 € SUM: 2.500 € UMR: 5.000 €

UNICAL: 2.500 € UNILIM: 5.000 € UNSA: 2.500 € UWB: 5.000 €




FRAMEWORK CONDITIONS – Context: Flagship Actions

OUR FLAGSHIP ACTIONS

- (1) The European Core Curriculum ("European Track") to broaden the Alliance's base by integrating EUPeace content into all curricula
- (2) Joint Degrees at Master level to deepen the Alliance's transformative impact by advancing towards European Degrees, and empowering EUPeace Alumni as change agents
- (3) The Living Peace Lab to recast the way we serve society by bringing together our staff, and students with regional, national, and international stakeholders
- (4) Internationalisation of School Teacher Education to shape society by leveraging future teachers' undervalued potential for impact
- (5) Strong Student Organisations to encourage the buy-in of our most crucial community by offering them the means to define their means of participation
