---

To foster student entrepreneurship and encourage concrete project development by raising awareness of entrepreneurship and innovation valorization. The programme uses EUPeace values as practical training opportunities, early professional project foundations and skills development. The goal is to support participating students in transforming ideas into real entrepreneurial projects, including ongoing collaborations with partner organizations.

## COURSE CONTENTS

---

The event will take place in two complementary stages:

- Phase 1 – February/May – Entrepreneurship awareness (online) with the organization of several awareness-raising sessions via videoconference with future participants, but open to all students from EUPEACE member universities.
    - The aim is to establish a common foundation (project presentation, language, tools, entrepreneurial approach, etc.), introduce the international teams and create a collective dynamic.
  - Phase 2 – June 2-3, 2026 – EUPEACE Entrepreneurship Night in Limoges. Student teams from partner universities will be welcomed to Limoges for an intensive 24-hour social entrepreneurship challenge ('24 hours to create a business') in English.

## TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Working languages: English

Participants: international student teams from EUPEACE

Possible external partnerships: local businesses, banks, incubators for logistical support or sponsorship, etc.

Accommodation and logistics (book hotel before/after event):

- Three full days of hospitality
- Provision of a venue open 24/7 capable of accommodating 30 students, 5-8 staff members (CAPSUL + International Division).
- Required spaces: main work room (capacity 40–50 seats), additional rooms for evening workshops/mentoring, rest and snack area.
