Executive Summary

At the University of Marburg, virtual mobilities are organized in the MO:VE (MarburgOnline:VirtualExchange) Programme. Participation in MO:VE courses is open to all students from EUPeace alliance member institutions free of charge. In contrast to students participating in Erasmus+ or Overseas physical mobility programs, students wishing to participate in MO:VE do not need to be formally nominated by their sending institution. Instead, a recognition consent form to be signed by the sending institution is embedded in the application process.
