Experimenting with Digital Tools to Learn Chinese in English:

*Activating Learning, Raising Intercultural Awareness and
Cultivating Pluriliteracies*

In this workshop, participants, be they teacher educators, or teachers in higher education and schools, will work together to (i) experience using digital tools to create more active, interactive and learner-centred learning environments (ii) gain intercultural awareness and (iii) better appreciate the notion of “*pluriliteracy*”.

This workshop has four objectives, which are of equal importance:

Objective 1: The first objective is for us to work together to personally experience using learning apps to learn something new. This something new is *Chinese*.

Objective 2: So, the second objective of this workshop is so we gain a little understanding of the “Chinese mindset”. For example, Chinese “intonations” are famous for being very difficult to detect, is that true? And Chinese logograms are so complex, is it important how we write them? And, if one woman plus one child means “good”, what does one woman sitting under a roof mean?

Objective 3: The third objective is to experience learning something unfamiliar through English, which is a foreign language for many teachers and students in European multilingual and bilingual schools and universities. If you want to refresh your English and experience 2 hours of using English to learn something unfamiliar (unless you are Chinese of course), this workshop is for sure for you.

Objective 4: The fourth objective is mainly for teachers and is about methodology. Since a researcher interested in designing learning materials and processes will be leading the Workshop, once in a while, participants will be invited to consider how certain learning apps had been used to create an engaging learning environment, and how the same apps could become painful or ineffective if not used well.
